WHAT IS “THERE’S A PIG IN MY CLASSROOM”?

“There’s A Pig In My Classroom” is an interactive, hands-on virtual fieldtrip. This experience takes classrooms on a trip through the Fair Oaks Pig Adventure to see up close how pigs are raised in Indiana and across the United States.

Classrooms receive curriculum for pre- and post-lesson plans to prepare students for their 45-minute virtual connection via Zoom. The lessons also allow teachers to continue the conversation about pork after the virtual experience.

In just three semesters, There’s A Pig In My Classroom has reached more than 18,000 students, growing in popularity in each semester.

Semester # of Students Reached




